

PA0550 Antifoam



DESCRIPTION

PA0550 is an anti-foaming agent that may be added to epoxies or urethanes to aide in removing mixed-in air during degassing (deairing) procedures. This product acts as a surfactant, lowering the surface tension of the resin, making it easier for air bubbles to grow in volume and release from the mixture. This product will lower the volume of foam expansion during this process. If used in the proper amounts, PA0550 will have no effect on cured mechanical properties.

Add a few drops (more for larger volumes) of PA0550 into the combined resin-hardener mixture before mixing. After mixing, place a couple of drops of PA0550 on the surface of the resin and place in the vacuum chamber. Allow the mixture to foam up under vacuum until it violently boils and collapses upon itself. At that point, the majority of the mixed-in air has been removed.

PACKAGING

PA0550 is packaged in 8-ounce bottles, available individually and in cases of 25 bottles. It is also available in gallon cans @ 8 lb. Net Weight each..
